### Signalmen

Worked on the railways before automated systems were created. They did a variety of jobs that ensured that trains ran on time without having accidents.

### Billy boy

A billy boy was a young person responsible for making tea for people working at railway yards, blacksmiths and building sites during break times.



### Nomenclator

In ancient Rome, a nomenclator announced the names of people or guests visiting their employer; usually an important figure such as royal people.

### Radio Actor

A kind of performer who was skilled in vocally portraying many different dialects and age ranges on a specific topic in the form of audio drama.

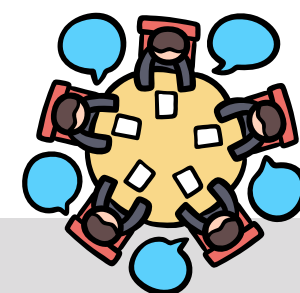

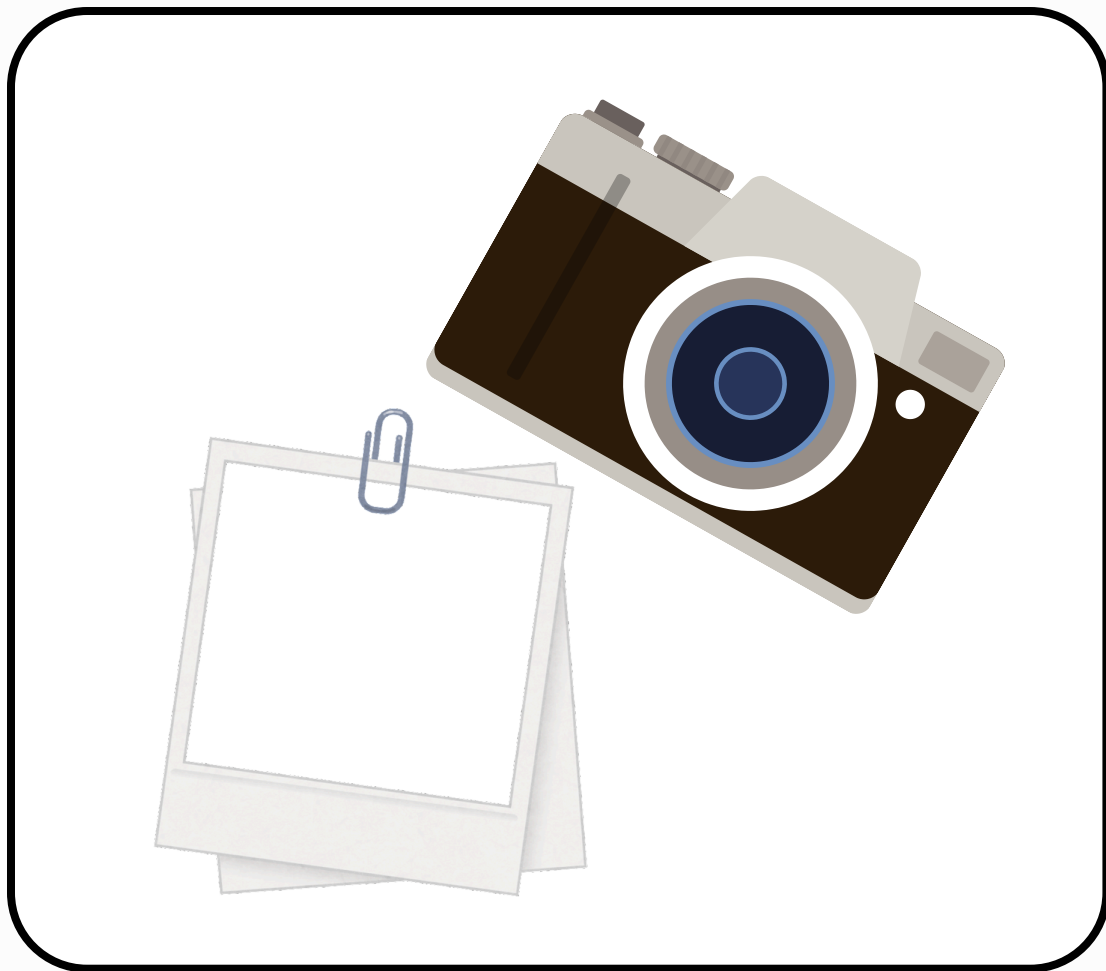
### Resume/Curriculum Vitae Writing Tips
